

## Care Information

### Bonded leather, embossed or smooth

No aggressive cleaning agents are to be used on any material, regardless of whether the surface is smooth or structured. Aggressive cleaning agents include abrasive products as well as products with a high acid content or self-cleaning properties. Cleaning products containing highly volatile solvents are not to be used. They may be too strong for the surface coating on fronts and cause damage over time.



***For this reason, do not use abrasives, shoe polish, coloured leather care products, cellulose and synthetic-resin thinners, acetone or similar cleaning products. Do not use steel wool or sponge scourers either!***

Under no circumstances should surfaces be cleaned with steam cleaners. Over time, moisture penetrating the surface may result in damage. Abrasive cleaning cloths must be avoided. This also includes the back of normal dishwashing sponges as they can leave scratches.

### Care Information

Treated properly, bound leather is not a sensitive material. Cleaning and caring for your furniture will help to retain its value and looks. As with any dirt and marks, the sooner a stain is dealt with, the greater the chances of removing it permanently.

Wipe all surfaces regularly with a damp cloth to remove dust and small amounts of dirt. Treat moderate amounts of dirt carefully with water and a little soap, curd or bile soap. Finish by washing off any soapy residue with warm water, then use a microfibre cloth, to wipe dry.

Remove stains, especially strongly-coloured substances and liquids, plus greasy splashes and similar stains immediately. Stains should not be allowed to dry. It may no longer be possible to remove dried-on substances or substances that have been allowed to penetrate over a prolonged period of time.

Treating the surface with alkaline and/or solvent-based cleaning products may damage the surface. It will become brittle and break. Oily and greasy substances in a care cream may have a negative effect on the surfaces and could leave smears.

Take great care not to damage the surfaces with sharp and pointed objects. It is impossible to remove scratches.

Please do not use any materials (e.g. labels) with solvent-based adhesives for identification purposes. It might not be possible to remove all traces of them.
